He teaches Agri-business Strategy, Agricultural and Rural Development, and Business Cases at SU. He also lectures at the Universities of the Free State, Pretoria, Antwerpen and Ghent, Belgium. To date, he has published more than 100 peer-group refereed scientific papers, and presented over 100 papers at local and international events. He is a National Research Foundation (NRF) rated scientist. Prof van Rooyen serves on several boards of agri-business companies and agencies. He is currently a board member of the International Agri-business and Food Industry Management Association and serves on an expert panel of the World Competitive Report, University of Laussanne, Switzerland, amongst others.
